

The Springfield Rail Improvements Project team hosted a Public Open House from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2016 at the Prairie Capital Convention Center. More than 80 citizens, elected officials and business people attended and spoke with project team members. Informational stations covered topics including construction segments, land acquisition, funding, the archaeological site, and the resource center.
